Category	Grade	Parameters
I	1 & 11	Presentation in the School Script
II	III &IV	Presentation in the School Script with their own creative style
III	V-VIII	Encouraged to showcase their unique calligraphy styles and creativity.

- 2. Students will be given the content in the school for their calligraphy work.
- 3. All necessary materials (A4 size paper, pens, etc.) to be brought by the student.
- 4. Judgement criteria for entries: neatness, presentation and aesthetic appeal of letterforms. Creativity would be an additional criterion for Categories II & III.
