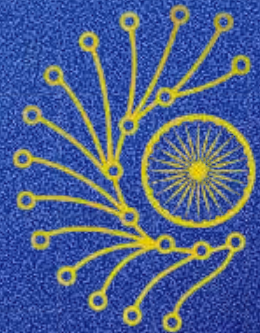

Please Note: The delegate fee is strictly non-refundable.

Information Regarding the Best School Delegation:

The delegation must fulfil the following requirements to qualify for the Best School Delegation Award:

1. There must be a **minimum of 13 delegates** participating as a part of the delegation.
2. There must be **at least one delegate** participating in each committee being hosted at **Falcon MUN & Youth Conclave**

Points to the delegation will be awarded according to the following rubrics:

- **3 Points** if a delegate from the delegation receives the **Best Delegate** award in their committee.
- **2 Points** if a delegate from the delegation receives the **High Commendation** award in their committee.
- **1 Point** if a delegate from the delegation receives the **Special Mention** award in their committee.

The delegation with the maximum number of points at the end of the conference will be the recipient of the **Best School Delegation Trophy!**

Specifics Of the Conference

Eligibility Criteria:

To participate in the conference, the delegate must satisfy one of the following conditions:

1. The candidate must be enrolled in a recognised educational institution as of 1st July 2026.
2. The candidate must be from Grade 6 or higher.

Dress code:

- **Day 1:** Western Formal Wear
- **Day 2:** Indian Ethnic Wear

Refreshments:

Breakfast, lunch, and high tea will be served on both days.
